






Founded in 1966

Why Pursue ADB Funded Contracts?

- Assured financing for goods, works, and services
- 2. Internationally accepted fair and transparent procurement procedures
- 3. Strong oversight by ADB

Types of business opportunities

Services

- Consulting: Project preparation & implementation, detailed design, site supervision (PMC), knowledge products, policy/advisory, staff consultants
- Non-consulting: Surveys, training, translation, event management

Supply of goods

Machinery, equipment, ICT, furniture, medical equipment


Civil works

- Roads, railways, bridges, hospitals, airports, schools, etc.
- EPC Power plants, pump stations, water treatment plants, heating plants

Relationships, Roles, and Responsibilities in Procurement


Two primary "streams" of procurement:

- ADB Technical Assistance (ADB = buyer)
- ADB-financed projects (borrower = buyer)

The Borrower (Executing Agency) is responsible for procurement of goods, works and services

ADB (under TAs) or Borrower select and recruit Consultants


Oversight: ADB reviews the procurement activities of EAs to ensure that proceeds of its financing are used in accordance with the bank's rules. This is done on either a prior review or postreview basis









Procurement Volume 2022








Consulting procurement by region (2020-2023)



Types of Consultants






Recruitment may be national or international

- International consultant may be from any ADB member country
- A firm is considered national if it is legally incorporated in that DMC
- An individual is national if a citizen of the DMC or, if a national from another member country, he/she legally resides and works in that DMC.



4. Bidding Strategies







Tips when considering ADB-financed projects/assignments

- Understand the country, project, and client requirements
- Collect relevant business intelligence network!
- Engage and partnership with firms likely to be shortlisted
- Position yourself to your competitive advantage
- Study the bidding documents and understand the procurement method and evaluation criteria
- Focus on performance and reputation for successful work
- Express interest
- Prepare a responsive and strong technical proposal
- Seek clarifications in writing
- Be ready for possible bid extensions or amendments



ASK QUESTIONS



Common Mistakes in preparing bids

- Bids not signed or Bids signed by a person who is not authorized signatory
- No Bid Security or Bid Securing Declaration (if required)
- Insufficient Amount of Bid Security, Incorrect Validity Period
- Lack of Supporting Documents (JV Agreements, Audited Financial Statements, Past Performance Certificates)
- Incomplete Bids / Partial Bids
- Absence of test reports (if required) as per bidding documents
- Inclusion of financial offer with technical offer where bid conditions require them to be separated (i.e. under 1S2E bid procedure)
- Failure to provide a Signed letter of Bid, a correct Bid Validity Period and the required Bid Security or Bid Securing Declaration and Priced BOQs are grounds for immediate disqualification of the Bid.
- Minor omissions to the documents required by the Bidding Documents may be clarified. Multiple minor omissions may add up to a major omission and if clarified would give the Bidder an unfair advantage







What NOT to do

- Failure to disclose conflict of interest (e.g., employees from EA included in a proposal)
- Firm or JV partners not from an ADB member country
- Submitting proposal late
- Failure to respond to client requirements
- Conditional bids
- Incomplete/noncompliant bids, e.g., missing bid security, letter of bid not signed, JV agreement missing, bid envelopes not properly marked, etc.
- Integrity violations in the bidding process

When in doubt, always seek written clarification





Debriefing:

- Unsuccessful bidders may request debriefing from the procuring entity (the EA or ADB). If they are not satisfied with the explanation given, they may submit a complaint.

 Debriefings are an excellent learning opportunity for future bids!

Complaints:

- Bidders may file complaint directly with ADB and may copy ADB on correspondence with EAs.



Individual Consultants

All Individual Consultants must:

- . Be a citizen of an ADB member country*
- Be competent and qualified for the work they are recruited to perform
- Not be on any ADB sanction or suspension list due to integrity violations or poor performance, or on any recognized terrorism list

*Note: Consultants from non-ADB countries may be engaged only if a project allows it.



Consulting Firms

All Consulting Firms must:

- Be legal entities that have the capacity to enter into binding and enforceable contracts with the ADB
- Be incorporated or legally established in an ADB member country*
- Not be on any ADB sanction or suspension list due to integrity violations or poor performance, or on any recognized terrorism list
- Have a bank account for financial transactions

The ADB's requirements on place of incorporation or legal establishment are as follows:

- Corporations or companies must be incorporated in an ADB member country*
- Partnerships that are not incorporated and have individual members must be duly registered in an ADB member country*
- Universities, institutions, public sector organizations and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that are not legally incorporated must provide details that establish their legal capacity to enter into binding and enforceable contracts with the ADB (e.g. by charter, statute, etc.)

*Note: Consultants from non-ADB countries may be engaged only if a project allows it.



Executing Agencies

Executing Agencies (EAs) are government or nongovernment agencies that work with ADB to monitor/implement a project or program. The executing agency may also be a "borrower." To request an EA account for posting recruitment notices, email the following details to your ADB Project Officer, with csrn@adb.org, in copy.

- 1. Name and address of the agency
- ADB Agency Code (can be obtained from ADB Project Officer/Analyst)
- 3. Preferred Username
- First and Last Name of the agency representative
- 5. Email address of the agency representative

Note: This registration procedure is for EAs only and does not apply to either consulting firms or individual consultants.

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

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


